Notice is hereby given that the Board of Directors of the Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency (SAFCA), Sacramento, California, will receive sealed bids as follows:

CONSTRUCTION COST: \$6,000,000

CONTRACTOR'S CALIFORNIA LICENSE AND/OR CLASS REQUIRED: General Engineering Class A; HAZ Hazardous Substance Removal Certification; and Class C-57 Well Drilling Contractor (for work on monitoring wells) HAZWOPER certificates are required for all employees.

PRE-BID INSPECTION/SITE VISIT DATE; TIME; AND LOCATION: April 10, 2019, 10 a.m., 50035 Highway 126, West Sacramento

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The work performed under this Contract includes the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment and supervision for the remediation of the former Bryte Landfill (former Landfill) and construction of a corrective action management unit (CAMU) to relocate waste from the former Landfill property. This work includes excavating and hauling cover material and waste, excavation of sediment from a drainage canal, material placement in the CAMU, treatment of waste material to stabilize metals concentrations, compaction, and vegetation of CAMU cover. The former Landfill property and canal will be backfilled, compacted, and vegetated.

A pre-bid inspection and site visit will be held for the purpose of reviewing and answering questions regarding this project. Any interested contractor or his/her agent may attend. Representatives of SAFCA will be present for questions.

Award of this contract requires the bidder to have a valid California contractor's license with the classifications identified above. These requirements shall be met at the time of the bid opening. Award of the contract also requires the bidder to demonstrate, to the satisfaction of SAFCA, that the bidder possesses the experience required to perform the work specified in the contract. Bidders are required to submit Attachment C - Bidders Experience Questionnaire with their bid.

Each bid must be submitted on the bid form provided in the Contract Documents. Each bid must also be accompanied by security in the form of a bid bond issued by a corporate surety, a certified check or cashier's check payable to SAFCA, or cash for an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the aggregate sum of the bid.

The successful bidder shall be required to execute a Material and Labor Payment Bond and a Performance Bond, issued by a corporate surety, acceptable to SAFCA, each for not less than one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

SAFCA encourages the submission of bids and sub-bids by minority-owned and women-owned business enterprises.

This is a public works project in accordance with Section 1720 of the California Labor Code. No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5 [with limited exceptions from this requirement for bid purposes only under Labor Code section 1771.1(a)]. No contractor or subcontractor may be awarded a contract for public work on a public works project unless registered with the Department of Industrial Relations pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.

The County of Sacramento received final approval from the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations as a Labor Compliance Program effective March 15, 1994. All questions regarding this Labor Compliance Program should be directed to the Labor Compliance Section at (916) 875-2711.

This is a construction project in accordance with Section 1771.5 of the California Labor Code. All labor on the project shall be paid no less than the minimum wage rates as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations in accordance with Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code.

Copies of the minimum wage rates established by the Secretary of the U.S. Department of Labor (www.wdol.gov) and the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations (<http://www.dir.ca.gov/OPRL/PWD/index.htm>) are on file at the office of the Labor Compliance Program, 9700 Goethe Road, Suite D, Sacramento, CA 95827. These copies shall be made available to any interested party upon request.

Pursuant to California Contract Code Section 22300, the contractor may, at its own expense, substitute securities for any money being withheld by SAFCA to ensure performance under this contract.

SAFCA's board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any informality in any bid, and to determine which bid, in the judgment of the Board, is the lowest responsive bid of a responsible bidder.
