- **\$15,055,000,000,**
  - **Corps of Engineers authorized projects**
  - **Available until expended**
- **\$10,425,000,000**
  - **States and insular areas**
    - **Impacted by Hurricanes Harvey, Irma, and Maria**
- **Remainder**
  - **States and insular areas**
  - **More than one flood-related major Federally declared disaster**
  - **Calendar years 2014, 2015, 2016, or 2017**
- **60-days to assign projects**
