The FEIS is being filed with the Environmental Protection Agency and is being made available to interested parties for review and comment pursuant to regulations of the President's Council on Environmental Quality for implementing NEPA (40 CFR Parts 1500-1508). Printed copies of the report are available upon request. These documents are currently under review by the heads of Federal agencies and the Governor of the State of California. Upon receipt of their comments, the report of the Chief of Engineers will be finalized and submitted to the Secretary of the Army for transmittal to Congress.

The official closing date for the receipt of comments is 30 days from the date on which the notice of availability of the FEIS appears in the Federal Register. This closing date may be somewhat later than 30 days from the date of this letter.
