**ADOPTING ADDENDUM NO. 2 TO THE MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION
AND A REVISED MITIGATION MONITORING AND
REPORTING PROGRAM FOR
THE BRYTE LANDFILL REMEDIATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Sacramento Area Flood Control Agency (SAFCA) is the lead agency for the Bryte Landfill Remediation (Project); and

WHEREAS, the Project consists of removal of the existing Bryte Landfill and relocation to a California Department of Toxic Substance Control Corrective Action Management Unit (CAMU) compliant alternative site; and

WHEREAS, the Project is necessary in order to remediate the existing Bryte Landfill and make way for potential setback levees on the Yolo and Sacramento Bypasses which will improve flood protection for the Sacramento metropolitan area; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), SAFCA prepared an Initial Study/proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (IS/MND) that evaluated the environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, the IS/MND was circulated for public review from August 14, 2017 through September 12, 2017; and

WHEREAS, the IS/MND concluded that significant environmental effects on various resources would be avoided or reduced to less-than-significant levels by mitigation measures identified in the IS/MND; and

WHEREAS, the IS/MND was finalized (Final MND) and the Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program (MMRP) was prepared incorporating mitigation measures from the Final MND; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted the Final MND and MMRP and approved the Project by adoption of Resolution 2017-078 on September 21, 2017; and

WHEREAS, geotechnical design refinements led to the need to prepare Addendum No. 1 to the MND and MMRP; and

WHEREAS, the Board adopted the Addendum No. 1 to the MND and MMRP by adoption of Resolution 2018-026 on May 17, 2018; and


WHEREAS, revisions in the Project footprint require additional vegetation clearing and a larger parcel rezoning action increasing the loss of farmland, has led to the need to develop an addendum to the Final MND (Addendum No. 2) and a revised MMRP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SACRAMENTO AREA FLOOD CONTROL AGENCY BOARD OF DIRECTORS THAT:

1. The Board hereby finds the foregoing recitals to be true and correct.
2. The Board of Directors has independently considered Addendum No. 2 to the Final MND and the revised MMRP (attached hereto as Exhibits A and B), and has considered the information contained therein prior to acting on the Project.
3. The Board of Directors hereby finds that Addendum No. 2 to the Final MND and the revised MMRP were prepared and considered in accordance with the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines; constitutes an adequate, accurate, objective, and complete addendum to an MND and an MMRP in accordance with the requirements of CEQA and the State CEQA Guidelines; and reflects the independent judgment and analysis of the Board of Directors.
4. The Board of Directors finds that, on the basis of the whole record before it, there is no substantial evidence that the revised Project will have a significant effect on the environment.
6. The Board of Directors hereby adopts Addendum No. 2 to the Final MND and the revised MMRP for the Bryte Landfill Remediation Project.
7. The Board of Directors hereby adopts and incorporates into the Bryte Landfill Remediation Project all the mitigation measures identified in the revised MMRP.
8. SAFCA, located at 1007 7th Street, 7th Floor, Sacramento, CA 95814, shall be the custodian of the documents which constitute the record of proceedings upon which this decision is based.
